

IMPORTANT!!!!

Dear Parent/Guardian:

A new California law now requires students to be vaccinated against whooping cough.

7th through 12th grade student will need to show proof of having received a Tdap booster shot after the age of 7, or they WILL NOT BE ALLOWED to start school in August until proof of immunizations is given to the school.

If your child has received the booster shot of the Tdap, **please bring a copy of proof of vaccination to the counseling office or to the Health Office as soon as possible.** If your child did not receive the booster shot vaccine at the age of 7 or older, please take him/her to your doctor or one of the clinics listed below.

Kaiser Permanente members can get the vaccine for free.

Lodi Memorial Clinic will provide the vaccine for establish patients only and depending on insurance.

Lodi Health Center has the vaccine available for \$15 with or without insurance. Hours are from 8am-11am and 1pm-4pm, no appointment necessary.

Sacramento Native American Health Service has the vaccine available regardless of insurance for \$20, walk-ins, just let personnel know you need a shot.

Galt Medical Center vaccine is available but only through appointment with provider.
