**Algebra Requirement:**

Commencing with the 2003-04 school year California Education Code 51224.5 specifies that beginning with the graduating class of 2003-2004 all graduating high school students must complete the following minimum graduation requirements for mathematics:

1. Complete at least two courses in mathematics in grades nine through twelve.
2. One or a combination of these courses must meet or exceed the content standards for Algebra 1.

**California State University and University of California Admission Requirements**

<b>History/Social Science</b>	<i>2 years required</i> , Two years including one year of U.S. history.
<b>English</b>	<i>4 years required.</i> Four years of college preparatory English.
<b>Mathematics</b>	<i>3 years required, 4 years recommended</i>
<b>Laboratory Science</b>	<i>2 years required, 3 years recommended</i>
<b>Foreign Language</b>	<i>2 years required, 3 years recommended.</i> Two years of the same language other than English.
<b>Visual and Performing Art</b>	<i>1 year required</i>
<b>College Preparatory Electives</b>	<i>1 year required</i> , ie: visual and performing arts, history, social science, English, advanced mathematics, laboratory science, and language other than English.
